

Proverbs 19:13 - A foolish son [is] the calamity of his father: and the contentions of a wife [are] a continual dropping.

Genesis 2:18King James Version (KJV)

18 And the Lord God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him. He didn't make a Mona who wanted her own way, He made woman to help the man. Now to me helping the man means to stand by him, be there when he needs her and to love him unconditionally. Years ago I never saw the seriousness of this, but as time has gone by I am seeing more and more that a man needs a woman and the woman needs a man. I have preached many times at woman's meetings and as I spoke I could see the looks on the faces of the ladies. Let's look at Scripture again regarding this. Genesis 2:20-25
20 And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for Adam there was not found an help meet for him.

- 21 And the Lord God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof;
- 22 And the rib, which the Lord God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man.
- 23 And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.
- 24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.
- 25 And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed.

From the very beginning God had a plan, and many of us have by not listening to what God had to say made many lives miserable. Mona and her selfish desires caused many heartaches for her husband. See, her husband loved the Lord very much, He was a good husband too that loved Mona but as time went by he knew that the Lord wanted him to go to the Mission Field. For a few years God was tugging at his heart and then Mona and him sat down to discuss what God was telling him. She agreed that God was telling him to go but Mona at that time proceeded to tell him that she couldn't come right away but if he went she would surely follow within a short time. Sadly, Mona had no intentions of coming from the beginning. One excuse after another kept making time pass and her husband bore the pain of her loss. He never did understand what had gone wrong. There were times when he even blamed himself thinking if he had maybe done things differently but when in all actuality it had nothing to do with him It was Mona.... Mona didn't know her place as a Christian wife. When I think of Mona I think of Queen Vashti. Remember that story in the Bible... Let's take a look again at the scriptures, I thought we should start at the beginning of the book of Esther to help you understand more fully...

Esther 1 King James Version (KJV)

- 1 Now it came to pass in the days of Ahasuerus, (this is Ahasuerus which reigned, from India even unto Ethiopia, over an hundred and seven and twenty provinces:)
- 2 That in those days, when the king Ahasuerus sat on the throne of his kingdom, which was in Shushan the palace,
- 3 In the third year of his reign, he made a feast unto all his princes and his servants; the power of Persia and Media, the nobles and princes of the provinces, being before him:
- 4 When he shewed the riches of his glorious kingdom and the honour of his excellent majesty many days, even an hundred and fourscore days.
- 5 And when these days were expired, the king made a feast unto all the people that were present in Shushan the palace, both unto great and small, seven days, in the court of the garden of the king's palace;

6 Where were white, green, and blue, hangings, fastened with cords of fine linen and purple to silver rings and pillars of marble: the beds were of gold and silver, upon a pavement of red, and blue, and white, and black, marble.

7 And they gave them drink in vessels of gold, (the vessels being diverse one from another,) and royal wine in abundance, according to the state of the king.

8 And the drinking was according to the law; none did compel: for so the king had appointed to all the officers of his house, that they should do according to every man's pleasure.

9 Also Vashti the queen made a feast for the women in the royal house which belonged to king Ahasuerus.

10 On the seventh day, when the heart of the king was merry with wine, he commanded Mehuman, Biztha, Harbona, Bigtha, and Abagtha, Zethar, and Carcas, the seven chamberlains that served in the presence of Ahasuerus the king,

11 To bring Vashti the queen before the king with the crown royal, to shew the people and the princes her beauty: for she was fair to look on.

12 But the queen Vashti refused to come at the king's commandment by his chamberlains: therefore was the king very wroth, and his anger burned in him.

13 Then the king said to the wise men, which knew the times, (for so was the king's manner toward all that knew law and judgment:

14 And the next unto him was Carshena, Shethar, Admatha, Tarshish, Meres, Marsena, and Memucan, the seven princes of Persia and Media, which saw the king's face, and which sat the first in the kingdom;)

15 What shall we do unto the queen Vashti according to law, because she hath not performed the commandment of the king Ahasuerus by the chamberlains?

16 And Memucan answered before the king and the princes, Vashti the queen hath not done wrong to the king only, but also to all the princes, and to all the people that are in all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus.

17 For this deed of the queen shall come abroad unto all women, so that they shall despise their husbands in their eyes, when it shall be reported, The king Ahasuerus commanded Vashti the queen to be brought in before him, but she came not.

18 Likewise shall the ladies of Persia and Media say this day unto all the king's princes, which have heard of the deed of the queen. Thus shall there arise too much contempt and wrath.

19 If it please the king, let there go a royal commandment from him, and let it be written among the laws of the Persians and the Medes, that it be not altered, That Vashti come no more before king Ahasuerus; and let the king give her royal estate unto another that is better than she.

20 And when the king's decree which he shall make shall be published throughout all his empire, (for it is great,) all the wives shall give to their husbands honour, both to great and small.

21 And the saying pleased the king and the princes; and the king did according to the word of Memucan:

22 For he sent letters into all the king's provinces, into every province according to the writing thereof, and to every people after their language, that every man should bear rule in his own house, and that it should be published according to the language of every people.

When I read this it makes it so clear to me what God had planned for a man and a woman. Queen Vashti reminds me of Mona a lot. She was defiant and was going to do what she wanted to do. But, not only did it come back to bite her but she lost out on so much in life that was right there in front of her all the time. For her to act that way she did shows me that her husband was a good man, sadly she didn't care much now did she.

Some may say well it might have been that she was having a good time and didn't want to leave or that she was going through changes in her own body that made her act that way. I hear so many woman say at a certain age that they just are not the same as they used to be but being a woman myself I see where many excuses are made to the husband so that a woman can get her own way. Now men don't think like woman do and they tend to believe what they are told, especially when they love that woman.

It really is sad how woman lose out a lot by not respecting their husbands. Ladies if your husband loves the Lord and is genuinely trying to do what God wants him to do then it is your place to support your husband in all his undertakings. GOD will bless a woman who stands by her husband.

Here is a few more Scriptures for woman....

1 Peter 3:1-2 - Likewise, ye wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives;

Ephesians 5:21-33 - Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.

Proverbs 12:4 - A virtuous woman is a crown to her husband: but she that maketh ashamed is as rottenness in his bones.

1 Peter 3:5-6 - For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands:

Ephesians 5:24 - Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything.

Proverbs 11:22 -As a jewel of gold in a swine's snout, so is a fair woman which is without discretion.

1 Corinthians 7:10-11 - And unto the married I command, yet not I, but the Lord, Let not the wife depart from her husband:

WELL, I can imagine this book being thrown across the room by some and never picked up again. BUT, we don't really see ourselves as at fault in marriages ... Am I right? - 30 Charm is deceptive, and beauty is fleeting; but a woman who fears the Lord is to be praised.
- 31 Honor her for all that her hands have done, and let her works bring her praise at the city gate.

- 13 And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity.
